Good Afternoon from After School,

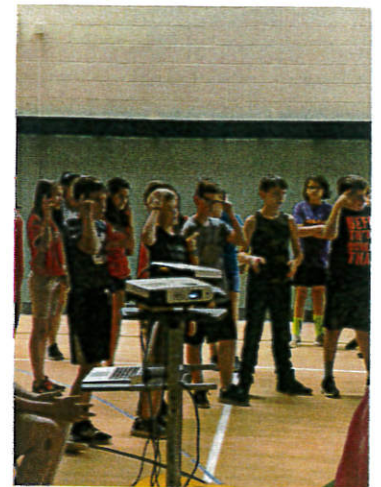

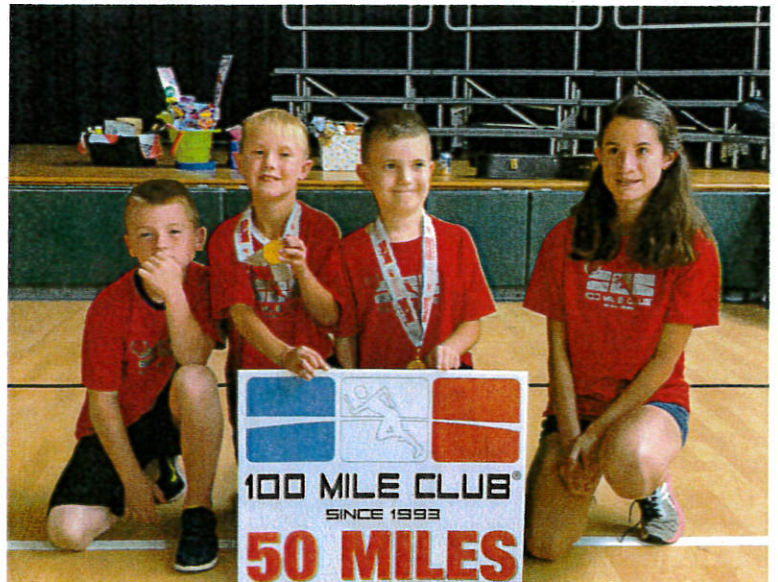
