Dear Parents and Guardians of Erving Elementary School Students,

As many of you know, Mitchell Grosky, retired teacher and principal in Athol, and husband of Anne Grosky (EES Teacher), took photographs of our school play in April. Mitch has posted those on a photo site at Walgreen's for the convenience of parents and families who wish to order photos. He had posted earlier this year on the same site, a large collection of photos from the December concert at Erving Elementary School. Please see his letter to Erving families below.

Dear Families,

Having heard that families would like to order photographs from the collection of 432 play photos that I took at Erving Elementary School in April, I have placed the entire collection on the Walgreen's photo site.

Although I have absolutely no connection or arrangement with Walgreen's or Walgreen's Photo Service, I have used this site extensively in the past because of its convenience, its low cost for purchasing prints, and its relatively high quality (especially for that price). Currently 4x6 prints are only about 33 cents each (depending how many you order), but the store often has sales, reducing the cost to 12-20 cents for a 4x6. You can also purchase larger size prints. Currently, Walgreen's is charging \$2.99 for a 5x7 print, and \$3.99 for an 8x10 enlargement. Please note, that I have only taken the step of placing these on Walgreen's as a service to Erving Elementary School and Erving families; I receive absolutely no commission whatsoever from Walgreen's or from anyone else for placing the high resolution photos on the Walgreen's site or for any orders that are made or any photos that are purchased.

Having used the service very successfully for many special events in the past, I am hopeful that you will find that it both meets your needs and provides you with some precious memories of the play, as well as memories of the December concert. I have found their turnaround time and their delivery of the photos by mail to be very quick and efficient, but your experience may vary. I also found it to be more convenient and cost-effective to have the photos delivered to my home, rather than to pick them up at a nearby Walgreen's, but again, your experience may vary. In order to purchase prints, it is possible that you may have to register with Walgreen's, but I believe that there is not a cost for registration alone.




1, 2, 3 Grow! Child Development Program for Families


