
You are invited to our Holiday Concert and Cookie Exchange. All classes in grades Preschool-6 are participating in addition to a performance by our band and chorus students.

Holiday Concert and Cookie Exchange Dismissal


Dismissing your child after the Cookie Exchange and before lunch?
