

We, as mathematicians, have been using "ten frames" for quite some time during Math class. We are familiar with how a ten frame is made and used to see groups of numbers within ten. Now we are exploring numbers larger than 10 through the use of handheld arrays (5x5). The second graders created two groups by selecting two different colors. They showed their friends twice for a short period of time then asked them how many they saw. The conversations were beautifully reflective and inclusive! We captured a few of the deep learning moments here...Enjoy!




Community Network for Children PROGRAM SCHEDULE
