Potatoes are yucky! You should never try and eat one. They are tasteless. When you eat them, there's no flavor in your mouth.





Erving Elementary School Kindergarten

Erving Elementary School is beginning kindergarten registration for the 2021-2022 school year.

If you have a child who will be 5 years old by September 1, 2021, and you live in the town of Erving, they are eligible to attend kindergarten at Erving Elementary School.

Please pick up a registration packet at the school or contact the school at (413) 423-3326 to have a registration packet sent to you.

Any child currently attending preschool at Erving Elementary School that will move on to kindergarten next year is automatically enrolled for next year and a registration packet was sent home with your child in April.

All registration forms need to be returned by May 14, 2021.

If your child is kindergarten eligible but will not be attending Erving Elementary School, please call the school and let us know.

Erving Elementary School Preschool

Erving Elementary School is beginning to register preschoolers for the 2021-2022 school year.

Mask Hygiene

Do you know how often you should change your mask? How often should it be washed?



Cloth mask should be changed and then washed after each wearing or sooner if they look dirty. Our students are wearing their masks all day - think of all the germs, food and dirt those masks collect by the end of the school day!

I treat my mask like the rest of my clothing. Each day I change out of my dirty clothes and launder them before wearing them again - I do the same with my mask!

You can include your cloth masks in your regular laundry, using your typical detergent and drying them in the dryer or hanging to dry. If you prefer, you can wash them by hand but be sure to rinse well to thoroughly remove any residual soap or detergent. Make sure masks are completely dry before wearing again. It's difficult to breathe through a wet mask.

If you don't already, please consider sending your student in with multiple masks for use during the day. As the days get warmer, masks will get soiled with sweat much quicker.

Don't forget to take the dirty masks out of the backpack at the end of each day!
