Dear Union #28 Community,

As you may be aware, on Thursday, May 13, 2021, the Center for Disease Control (CDC) updated their guidance relative to mask wearing, which states in part, "Fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance".

Today, Governor Baker announced that the Commonwealth's face covering order will also be rescinded on May 29. The Department of Public Health will issue a new face covering advisory consistent with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's updated guidance. New guidance states that "Face coverings will still be mandatory for all individuals on public and private transportation systems (including rideshares, livery, taxi, ferries, MBTA, Commuter Rail and transportation stations), in healthcare facilities and in other settings hosting vulnerable populations, such as congregate care settings". Additionally, the (Baker-Polito) Administration also announced updates that will be effective May 18 to revise face covering requirements for youth and amateur sports and other guidance relating to childcare programs and K-12 schools.

In Erving School Union #28, we still have a policy in place in all of our Union #28 schools, <u>Policy EBCFA</u>, <u>Face Coverings</u>, that states, "This policy will remain in place until rescinded by the school committee". We will be awaiting updates and guidance later this week from the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and Commissioner Jeffrey Riley. We will share any guidance or updates with you once it has been received.

Until further notice, our mask policy remains in effect. Thank you for your continued support and understanding as we navigate these times.
